

How deep should a pallet rack be?

Rack depth is determined by the width of the uprights that the beams are fastened to. Typically you'll want three inches of overhang on both the front and the back of the rack, so you can subtract 6" from your pallet depth to determine the required rack depth. For 48" pallets you would want a racking depth of 42".

How deep are server rack cabinets?

Depth is the least standardized of the various server cabinets. Height can be in rack units (U) and width at 19 inches, but depth requires more precise attention. That's why it is so crucial to know about the standard server rack cabinets depth range.

How deep is a rack?

The most common depth of uprights is 42", but many other sizes are available, including 24", 36", 44" and 48". Unlike beams, uprights are measured from outside edge to outside edge. For rack height, there are many things to consider.
