How to install an AED unit?

Insert the AED Device: Place the AED unit inside the cabinet according to the manufacturer's guidelines. Make sure it is resting securely and that any connected accessories, like pads and scissors, are readily accessible. 3. Connect the Pads and Battery: Install the AED pads and the battery as per the AED model's instructions.

How to install AED pads & battery?

Connect the Pads and Battery: Install the AED pads and the battery as per the AED model's instructions. Verify that they are in proper working order by checking the built-in indicator lights. 4. Activate the AED: Turn on the AED to ensure it is functional. Most AEDs come with a self-test feature that will indicate if they are ready for use.

Where should an AED be placed?

The main objective is to place the AED where it can be accessed quickly in an emergency. High-traffic areas where people gather frequently are typically the best spots. Examples include the reception area, main corridors, or near communal facilities like lunchrooms and restrooms. Consider the layout of your premises.

Insert the key into the activation switch mounted in the cabinet . Turn the key to the unarmed position as shown in Figure 1. Install the 9 volt battery into the holder mounted on the under side of the cabinet ...

The alarm requires a 9-volt alkaline battery which provides power to the alarm & strobe for about 2 years To check the battery, make sure the alarm key and alarm switch are both turned to the ON position, ...

Installing the Batteries: Insert the key into the activation switch mounted in face of the door. Turn the key to the unarmed position as shown in Figure 1. Remove the two thumb nuts and circuit board cover ...
