

## Best way to remove varnish from steel cabinet

How do you remove varnish from wood?

Pour a small amount of xylene onto a soft cloth. Gently rub the cloth over the varnished surface. Let the xylene sit for a few minutes to dissolve the varnish. Step 3: Varnish Removal Once the varnish begins to soften, use a clean cloth to wipe it away.

How do you clean xylene varnish?

Thoroughly clean the steel with a degreasing agent to remove any remaining residue, such as varnish particles, stripper residue, or fingerprints. Rinse the steel with clean water and allow it to dry completely.

Varnish and paint remover or heat gun + scrapers are the two best ways to remove finish usually. You can use a card scraper to scrape finish off large flat surfaces in particular, but it takes some ...

You can use a belt sander with a coarse grit to remove thick coats of paint and varnish moving the sander along with the grain of the wood. You can use a finer grit for thinner finishes.
