George Horatio Nelson, 1st Baron Nelson of Stafford (26 October 1887 - 16 July 1962), known as Sir George Nelson, 1st Baronet, from 1955 to 1960, was a British engineer who was chairman of English Electric from 1933 to 1962.

Who founded George Nelson & Associates?

Herman Miller founder D.J. De Pree saw the article and was so impressed that he paid a visit to Nelson in New York and convinced him to be his director of design, which spurred Nelson to found his design firm, George Nelson & Associates.

Who was George Nelson?

George Nelson dominated the Mid-Century Modern design and architecture scene and he is considered to be amongst the most influential designers ever.

When did George Nelson start a design studio?

Using the money he earned as Director of Design for Herman Miller, in 1947 Nelson opened a design studio in New York City. On October 26, 1955, he incorporated it into George Nelson Associates, Inc., and moved to 251 Park Avenue South.
